

Submission Guidelines

The Pardee Periodical Journal of Global Affairs seeks original, thought-provoking research and policy papers relevant to the field of global studies. The Editorial Board accepts submissions on a rolling basis. Each semester, the Editorial Board announces a submission deadline in a formal call for papers. Papers submitted after the submission deadline are considered for the following issue.

Qualifications

Candidates in a graduate degree program may submit their work to the journal. Recent graduates from an MA or PhD program may also submit work within the same calendar year as their graduation date.

Submission Instructions

Manuscripts should be sent as Microsoft Word documents (.doc or .docx) in an attachment to pardeegradjournal@gmail.com with the subject line [Author Last Name, Author First Name, Short Title of Paper].

Style & Format

- Manuscripts must conform to the Chicago Manual of Style, 16th edition, in citations and style.
- Manuscripts must be no longer than 8000 words (including citations and title page), and include footnotes and a bibliography. In compliance with Chicago Manual of Style conventions, full citations should be included in the bibliography with shortened citations in the footnotes.
- Manuscripts must be formatted in Times New Roman, 12 pt. font, double spaced, and with 1-inch margins. Headers, footers, and page numbers are not necessary.
- Each manuscript must contain a title page with the paper's title, a maximum 250-word abstract, a maximum 100-word author bio, a full word count, the degree the author is currently pursuing, and email contact information.

All submissions are subject to a blind review process. Accepted papers are subject to editorial modification. Additional information on submitting to the Pardee Periodical can be found at pardeeperiodical.com.
